The Design Technology and History departments are planning a visit Brunel's SS Great Britain in The Great Western Dockyard, Bristol on Thursday 21st March for Year 8 students. The trip will link in and support projects being covered in DT and History lessons.

The visit will include transport to and from Bristol, a guided tour of the ship, an interactive workshop, a break for a packed lunch followed by time to explore the museum. The cost of this trip is £18.00, which can be paid by cheque, cash (brought to the office) or by Parent Pay. Pupils need to wear school uniform and appropriate outdoor clothing. They will need a packed lunch/drink, please indicate on the slip below if your child is entitled to a FSM and if they would like the school to provide them with a lunch.

We have 90 pupils places available for this trip, which will be allocated on a first come first served bases. If we have sufficient over-demand for this trip, we will look into organising an extra trip on another date. We will leave school at 8.30am, and will return to school at around 3.30pm. Parents are responsible for their child's safe return home once we arrive back at Oakfield.
