I am pleased to inform you of an exciting trip we have organised for Year 6. We have a full day of activities planned at Braeside, Devizes. The activities we have booked are high ropes, survival skills and climbing wall. All activities will be run by the staff employed at Braeside which is operated by Wiltshire Council, and attached is a consent form which needs to be completed and returned to Mrs Reynolds.

The cost of the trip is £30.00 which covers all the activities and coach travel to and from Braeside, Devizes. Please notify us on the slip attached if your child has requirements we should be aware of in relation to the activities. We shall be leaving Oakfield at 9:00am (please arrive at normal time) and returning at approximately 4.30pm. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child's safe return home at that time.

Attached is a consent form which must be completed and returned to school in order for your child to participate in the activities. Please complete and sign the form including emergency contact details and return to school as soon as possible.

Please note that if the behaviour of your child falls below the expectations we have at Oakfield Academy, we will have to consider whether we believe it is safe to take them. We will consider the rights of everyone to enjoy their activity day. This will be the perfect opportunity for our pupils to put in to practice their team-building skills and challenge themselves to try new things together.

Pupils should come to school wearing suitable clothing and footwear:

Waterproof coat, comfortable walking shoes/trainers, warm jumpers, hats, gloves, change of clothing/footwear and a towel. They will also need a large plastic bag for any damp or dirty clothes, a refillable water bottle, snacks for breaktime, a lunch box with a packed lunch, and possibly suncream!
