Sam's Electron Therapy Fundraising. One of our Year 7 pupils, Sam, is visually impaired and has to travel to Berlin for Electron Therapy to try to improve his eyesight which is severely affected by Optic Nerve Atrophy. The treatment costs £5,000 per session.

Mrs Horton, Sam's mum has spoken with Miss Wilkes and the family are absolutely delighted with the support that the pupils and staff are offering. It is not available in the UK and is not funded by the NHS and so the cost of the travel and treatment need to be raised by the family themselves.
