Dear Parents,

You may already be aware that due to extreme pressures on school funding, we are struggling to finance the huge range of sports fixtures and opportunities that Oakfield choose to offer. This year, we have attended a huge amount of fixtures and tournaments with our pupils and been successful at qualifying for County Finals in a wide range of sports, meaning more transport is required. We are unable to finance anymore KS3 Fixtures to enable our pupils to attend the tournaments and fixtures we have planned for the last half term of this year. KS2 fixtures are funded by the Government's Primary Premium Sports Funding and we still have a little funding left to cover these! On average we have to find £220.00 every time we transport a team to a local fixture!

Having spoken to many pupils who represent Oakfield in our sports teams, they are very keen to continue with the remaining sports fixtures. We have 2 options that may help us. Firstly, if parents could support the fixtures below by driving a group of pupils to fixtures, that would be really helpful. They are all after school fixtures so leaving at approximately 3.15pm. If we qualify at the Mendip Tournament, we would then be invited to Somerset School Games at Millfield School, Street at the start of July. Also, this will be the same with the Year 8 Girls' Cricket home fixture against Writhlington this Thursday. If we win, we qualify for the next round.

Please complete the reply slip attached to firstly let us know if you can help on either date and how many pupils you could transport on that date, plus sign to say whether you are happy for your child to be taken to a fixture by another parent or a member of Oakfield staff.

Secondly, the KS3 girls' rounders and cricket team would like to do a cake sale after half term to help raise funds towards fixtures transport. We would be grateful if you could help them support their initiative by allowing them to make or buy cakes to bring to school on the day of the cake sale.

We are grateful for any help you are able to offer and I know the pupils will really appreciate it too.
